RESOLUTION REGARDING CREDIT/NO CREDIT GRADING IN P.E. LEVEL 100 COURSES

- WHEREAS, many Physical Education Level 100 activity courses do not lend themselves readily to grade discrimination, and
- WHEREAS, the recreational objectives of these courses are thought to be better accomplished if the pressure of "making a high letter grade" is removed, and
- WHEREAS, Physical Education Instructors report that the Credit/No Credit grading system seems to provide a more conducive climate for conducting an activity class, therefore be it
- RESOLVED, that the Academic Senate support and endorse the current policy of the Physical Education Department to use Credit/No Credit grading in P.E. Level 100 activity courses (PE 100-199).
