RESOLUTION ON SABBATICAL LEAVE REPLACEMENT

- WHEREAS, Sabbatical leaves are recognized and accepted as essential for continued faculty development; and
- WHEREAS, Sabbatical leaves are especially important to Cal Poly faculty who carry heavy teaching loads and whose opportunities for outside experiences are necessarily limited by the intensive teaching environment; and
- WHEREAS, The funding level for sabbatical leave replacement permits awards to only one half of the eligible applicants; and
- WHEREAS, The general standard for sabbatical leave replacement is one leave per twelve eligible faculty (8.3%); therefore, be it
- RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of California Polytechnic State University support President Warren J. Baker in his efforts to gain approval of a Program Change Proposal to provide one sabbatical leave per six eligible faculty.
