RESOLUTION ON
SUPPORT FOR PROPOSITION 47
(Kindergarten-University Public Education Facilities Act of 2002)**

1 **Rationale:** Proposition 47 (Kindergarten-University Public Education Facilities Act of 2002)
2 allows the State of California to issue \$13.05 billion in general obligation bonds for the
3 construction and renovation of public elementary, secondary, and higher education facilities
4 throughout the state. The need for such funding is acute at all levels of education which face
5 dramatic enrollment growth over the next decade. The proposition specifically would provide
6 \$496 million to the CSU.

8 WHEREAS, The overwhelming majority of students in the CSU system, and at Cal Poly in
9 particular, come from the public schools of California; and

11 WHEREAS, The current overcrowding at K-12 public schools in California is hindering
12 student success; and

13
14 WHEREAS, The deteriorating condition of many public school buildings in California makes
15 them unsafe for use by students; and

16
17 WHEREAS, Public schools throughout California are in need of substantial funds to improve
18 the infrastructure of the schools in order to meet student growth and modernize
19 the current facilities, therefore be it

20
21 RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Cal Poly support the passage of Proposition 47 in
22 the November 5 election; and, be it further

23
24 RESOLVED That the Academic Senate of Cal Poly direct its chair to write a letter to the local
25 newspapers expressing its support and asking for public support of this
26 proposition; and, be it further

27
28 RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Cal Poly send a copy of this to the Yes on 47
29 Campaign and to the Academic Senate CSU.
