Subject: Intellectual Property Review Committee (IPRC) 2006/07 AY Annual Report

The IPRC committee met Fall quarter, October 23, 2006 and did not have reason to meet Winter and Spring quarters 2007.

At the Fall meeting Art Chapman was elected chair, Dean Opava reviewed the University and Corporation patent status, and reported that there was no income for the past year from intellectual property.

The committee did not meet for the remainder of the year as the committee was not presented with University issues dealing with Intellectual Property policy nor Intellectual Property disagreements among University parties.

Dean Opava reported via email to the committee on May 8, 2007 that she had a request from other campuses (Channel Islands and Humboldt) to borrow from our IP policy in developing theirs. She gave permission to do so and added in her email that "it is a great reflection on the quality of our policy and having multiple campuses implement a substantially similar policy will add weight to ours".
