SYSTEM DOCUMENTATION

System documentation is available on reserve in the Library Reserve Room (when multiple copies are available), and from Information Technology Services.

ON-LINE DOCUMENTATION

On-line documentation is available through various system commands. What follows is a list of these documents and the commands that are used to access them:

% *man -k keyword | more*<CR>

Produces a list of appropriate manual pages on the system, based on the appearance of the keyword in the document synopsis.

% *man [section number] command*<CR>

Produces the indicated manual page on the user's terminal using the ***more*** command. Press the **<Space Bar>** to advance to the next screen.
