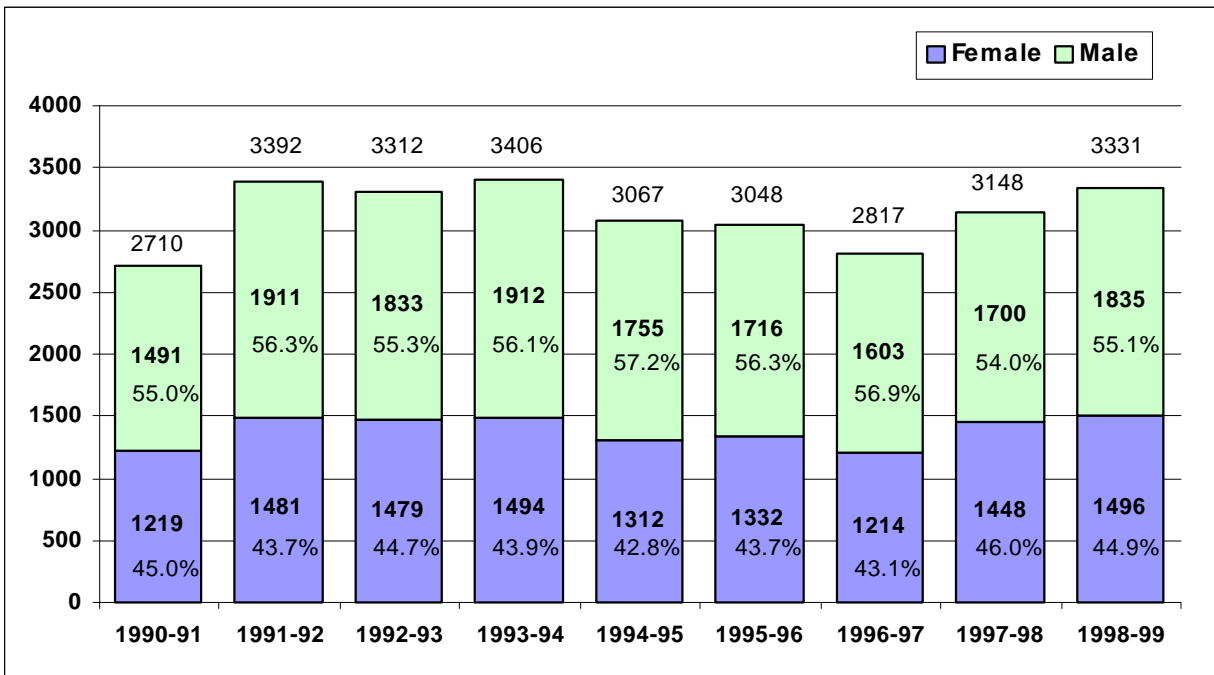

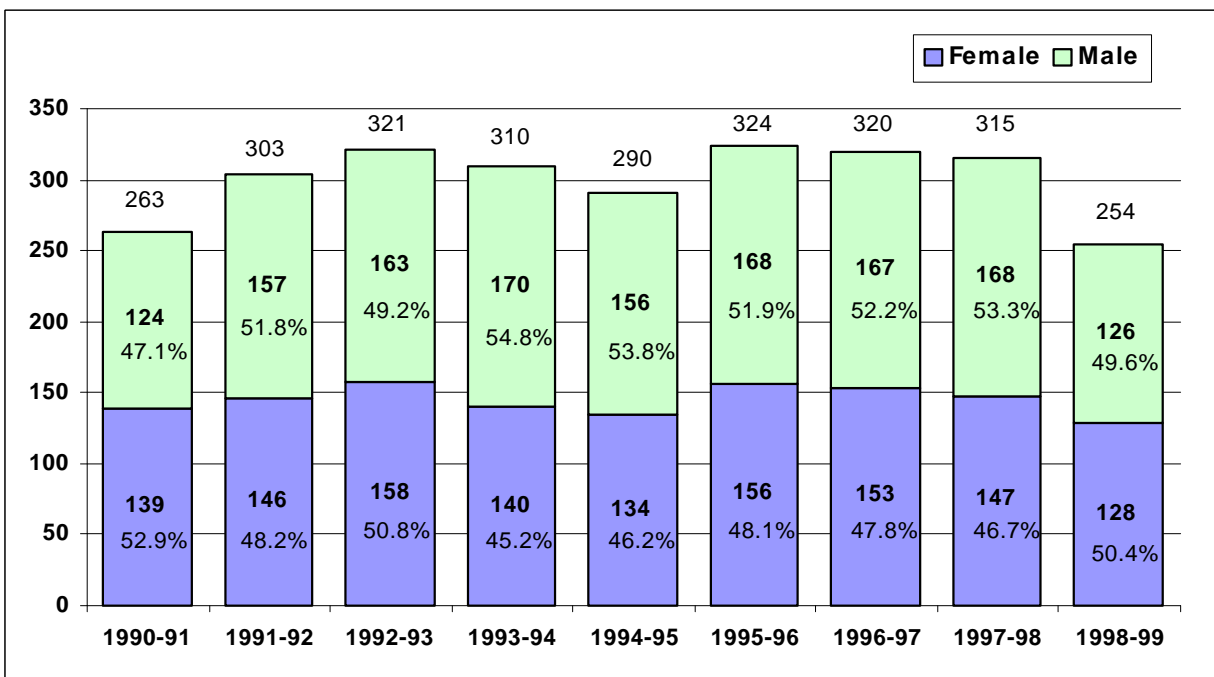

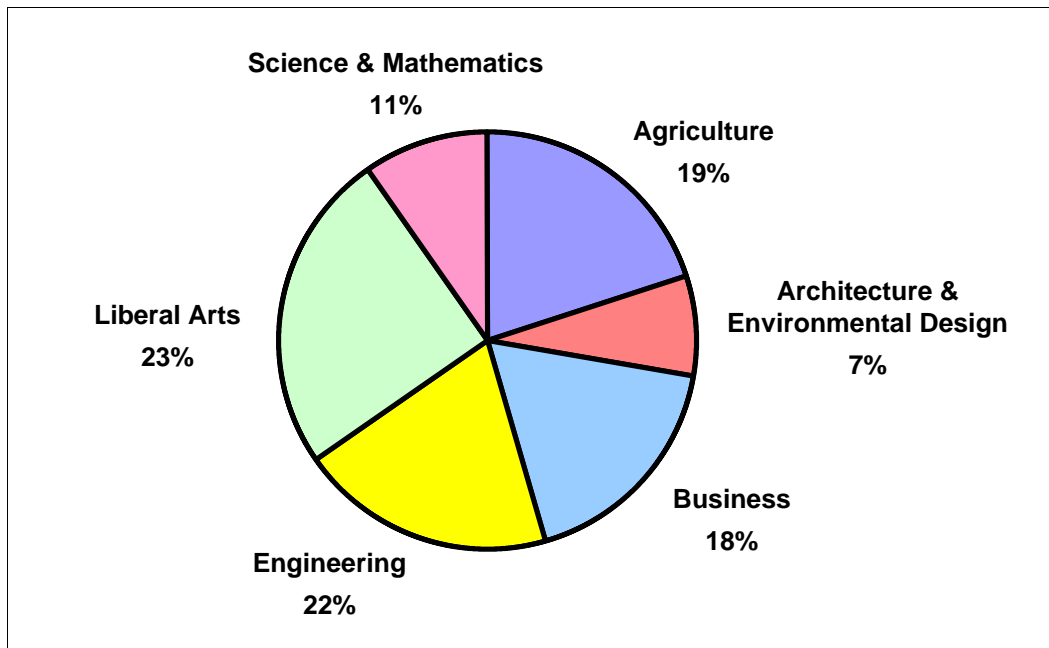

The percent graduated in 6 years includes degrees awarded in 4 and 5 year degree programs. The six year graduation rate reflects graduation through the sixth year including summer.
