

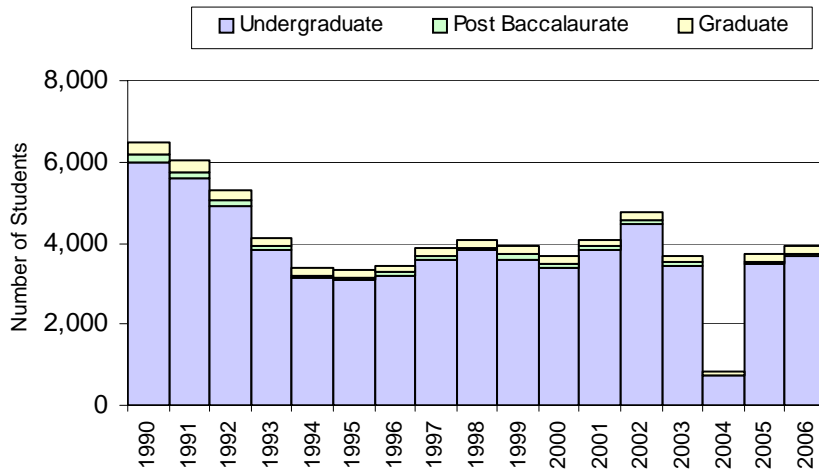

## UNIVERSITY HEADCOUNT ENROLLMENT



Summer 2006 total enrollment is up 5.1% over last Summer (2005). Summer 2006 undergraduate headcount is up 5.3% over last Summer.

Summer enrollment declined during the early 1990's and since 1993 has been hovering in the 3,000 to 4,000 range. There was a high point in 4,448 students in 2002 and an anomalous low point in 2004 caused by limits on enrollment necessary to comply with the state budget reduction.

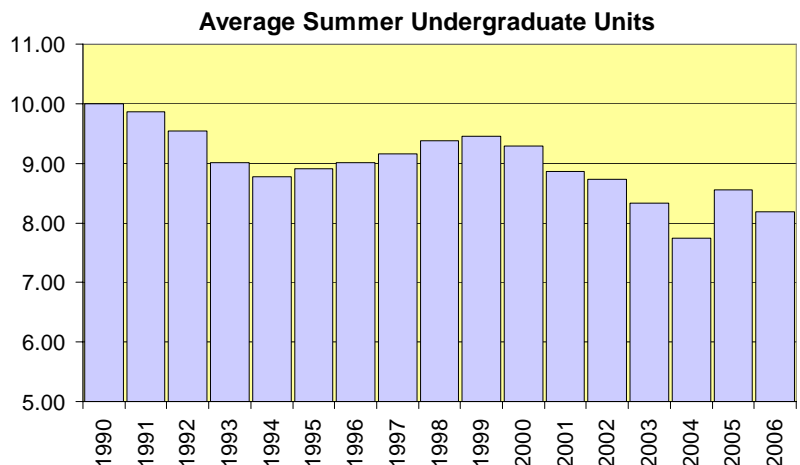
## AVERAGE STUDENT LOAD

Due to the nature of Summer term enrollment with reduced course offerings and services, average unit loads tend to fluctuate quite a bit over time.

Summer term average unit loads have generally been lower in the past 4-5 years than they were through most of the 1990's.

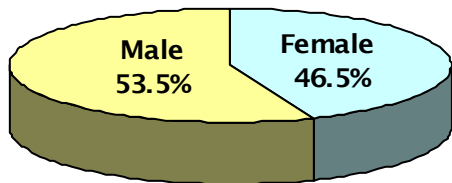
Graduate student loads did spike this Summer (2006) going over 7 units for the first time in 15 years.

It is difficult to draw any conclusions about post-baccalaureate unit loads since there have been a low number of these students enrolled in recent Summer terms.

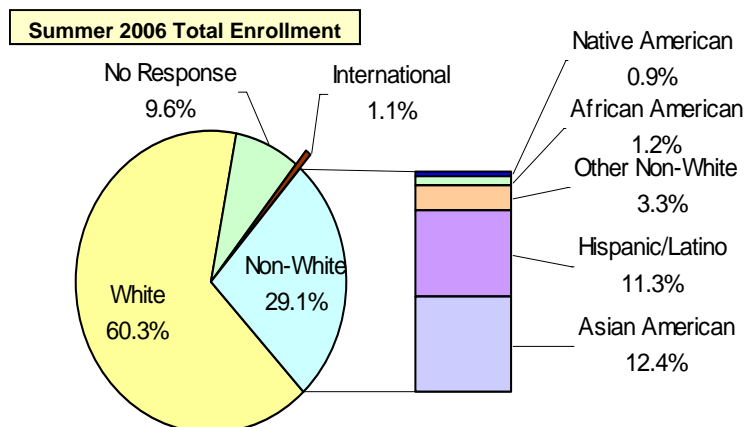
**TOTAL ENROLLMENT BY GENDER**

**TOTAL ENROLLMENT BY ETHNIC ORIGIN**



There was a higher proportion of non-white students enrolled in Summer 2006 (29.1%) than were enrolled during the previous academic year (26.3% in each of the three previous AY terms).

The Summer 2006 non-white proportion is only slightly above the Summer 2005 non-white proportion.

The low non-white proportion year of Summer 2004 is questionable because the limited enrollment that year could result in more variability. The second lowest non-white proportion since 1998 was 27.1% in Summer 2003.
