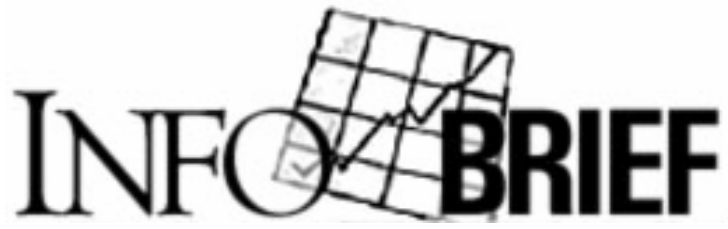

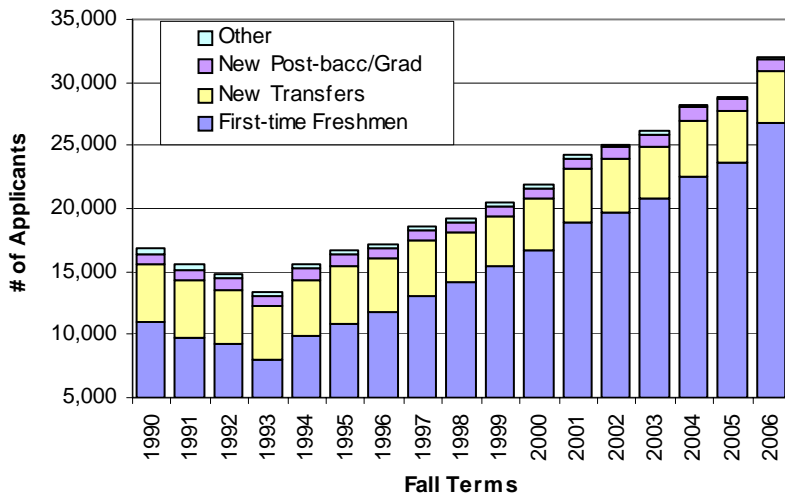

Fall 1990 - Fall 2006



Fall 2006 set a new record with 31,962 total applications. The number of total applications has been increasing since a low in Fall 1993. This increase is driven entirely by first-time freshmen (FTF) applications, which is also at an all-time high of 26,724. FTF applications increased 12.8% over last year, 59.7% since Fall 2000, and have more than tripled since Fall 1993.

New Transfer applications have been up and down over the years. New Transfer applications are up 5.0% from last year.

The Fall 2006 new post-baccalaureate/graduate enrollment of 824 is the lowest since Fall 2001 and is a 7.4% decline from last Fall.

The "other" group in the graph consists of non-degree seeking students (e.g. Exchange, Faculty/Staff waiver, etc.)

Accommodation Rates and Show Rates

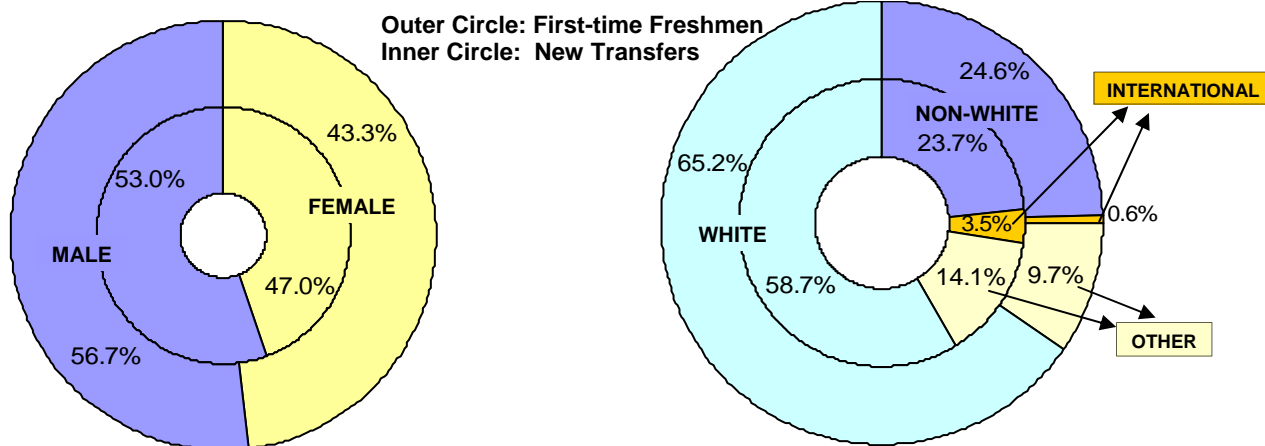
In Fall 2006 Cal Poly accommodated 46.6% of first-time freshmen (FTF) applicants. Of these 12,453 FTF accommodations, 29.5% enrolled, producing an entering FTF class of 3,668 students.

The College of Agriculture was able to accommodate the highest percentage of their FTF (68.0%) and also had the highest FTF yield (46.6%). The College of Science and Math accommodated a high percentage of FTF (59.9%), but ended up enrolling only 18.7% of those selected. Conversely, the College of Architecture & Environmental Design only accommodated 26.2% of their FTF applicants, but had 45.1% of their FTF accommodations enroll.

Cal Poly accommodated 39.2% of Fall 2006 transfer applicants. 46.5% of the 1,662 new transfer accommodations enrolled, resulting in a Fall 2006 new transfer class of 773 students.

Cal Poly exceeded its Fall 2006 first-time Freshman target by 1.7% with an enrolled class of 3,668 students.

The Fall 2006 FTF class had an average high school GPA of 3.70, an average SAT Reading score of 570, and an average SAT Math score of 615. The College of Engineering and the College of Architecture and Environmental Design had the highest average SAT scores among the colleges. Architecture and Business had the highest high school GPA's among the colleges.

Cal Poly exceeded its Fall 2006 new transfer target by 3.2%. The College of Liberal Arts continues to enroll the largest proportion of new transfers with 31.7% of the 773 new transfers in Fall 2006.

The average transfer GPA for Fall 2006 new transfers was 3.36 with the College of Business and College of Liberal Arts having the highest average GPA among the colleges.
