Bob Field is a Research Scholar in Residence at California Polytechnic State University where he has been supervising student projects as an adjunct physics professor for eleven years. He developed and taught a course on solar and global evolution and studies the structure and evolution of the Sun and the Earth. As a docent for over ten years, he prepared state park walks and animated slide shows in the Morro Bay State Park Museum of Natural History. He was an aerospace laser systems scientist for 20 years. He has toured 17 countries on six continents exploring ancient architecture and cultures.
