Q: Where do I get my response form and where do I turn it in?

A: You will receive an official response form at any of the formal presentations that we make on campus. There will be two Open Forums as well as presentations to each of the College Councils and to the ASI Board Of Directors. You can attend any one of those nine events. You would turn in your response form at that location. The time and location of each of these meetings will be advertised at least two weeks in advance. They have not yet been determined. However, all of the meetings will occur in the last week of February and first week of March.

Q: Is it possible to vote online?

A: No, response forms will be available at one of nine presentations. There will be two Open Forums, plus presentations to each of the College Councils and the ASI Board Of Directors. These presentations will occur between February 23 and March 4. The time and place of these meetings will be advertised shortly.

Q: Why are you not doing a referendum?

A: Because of the complicated nature of the proposal, which includes revenue to cover upcoming budget cuts, we had hoped to have more information about the state budget at the time of the consultations to help clarify the financial situation of Health and Counseling Services and the campus. Unfortunately, at this point we don't have much more information about the CSU budget or the University budget. However, alternative consultation gives the students the opportunity to provide more complex feedback to the President than simply a "yes" or "no" response.
