The largest in university history, this year's competition featured a jaw-dropping 262 entries, including tables, chairs, light fixtures, toys and other experimental design solutions. Vellum challenges students to dream up an original piece of furniture, source materials and build it. During a public exhibition of the pieces, a panel of judges, including faculty, architects, furniture designers and artists, evaluate each entry on functionality, individuality and beauty.
