Cal Poly Graduate Accepted to Erasmus Mundus Joint Master's Program

Torrey Gage-Tomlinson (Biology, '22) has been accepted into the Erasmus Mundus Joint Master in Global Change Ecology and Biodiversity Management (GLOBE), a highly competitive, international two-year graduate program focused on global change, biodiversity conservation and environmental management. Gage-Tomlinson will begin this fall at Universidad Rey Juan Carlos in Madrid, Spain, before continuing his studies at partner institutions in the United Kingdom, Mexico and Portugal. Since graduating from Cal Poly, Gage-Tomlinson has conducted field research in Ecuador and served as program director at Morro Coast Audubon Society, where he helped expand research opportunities for students from underserved Central Coast communities.

Building 26 Renovation Prep Work to Begin Aug. 31

Facilities Management and Development will begin preparatory work Aug. 31 for a year-long renovation of Building 26 that will add 10 classrooms with 424 seats and five faculty offices. Through Nov. 16, work will occur primarily on the first floor and include removal of flooring, ceiling tiles, furniture, debris and electrical and data cables. Portions of the first floor will be closed during this phase, with personnel and equipment working in and around the building. The next phase will include construction of new classrooms and faculty offices on the first floor, with work continuing through July 2027.
