Cal Poly Maritime Academy Hosts Gov. Newsom for Announcement of California Jobs First Grants

Cal Poly Maritime Academy hosted Gov. Gavin Newsom, California State University Chancellor Mildred García, Cal Poly President Jeffrey D. Armstrong and other leaders Wednesday on Mare Island for the announcement of \$48.5 million in California Jobs First investments designed to strengthen key industries, expand workforce development and support the creation of 20,000 jobs statewide. The announcement included more than \$8.2 million to strengthen the Bay/Delta region's shipbuilding sector. Cal Poly Maritime Academy has also been awarded \$5.8 million in California Jobs First funding to advance maritime workforce and industry development initiatives, including the creation of a maritime career pathway.
